Standard First Aid/Child First Aid Training Centre (SFA/CFA TC)

- Training Centres applying for new or renewal accreditation for SFA/CFA from 1st April 2020 onwards are to align their course materials with the respective new syllabus outlines. The rest of the TCs will need to align and implement the new SFA/CFA syllabus by 1st June 2020.
- 2. Audit Fee: \$\$535.00 (inclusive of GST) per audit, payable upon completion of audit application. Training centre which fails the first audit is required to pay for each subsequent audit. Institutions under SingHealth only need to pay \$\$500 (without GST) due to Group GST Registration.

- 10 Audit will not proceed and/or the accreditation fee forfeited, if:
 - a. the class is cancelled without informing SRFAC at least 1 week in advance
 - b. the class does not start within 30 minutes from the stated commencement time
- 11 There should be at least 3 learners to form a class for the accreditation audit.
- 12 Accreditation validity of 2 years will start from:
 - a. the approval date (for new TC accreditation); OR
 - b. the following calendar day after the current validity expires (for TC renewal accreditation)
- 13 Provider TCs will need to provide 1 date when seeking new accreditation and 3 dates for renewal accreditation.
- 14 TCs offering to provide E-learning packages for Standard First Aid and Child First Aid courses are recommended to seek approval with Skillsfuture Singapore (SSG) for the E-learning track to ensure consistency in the delivery of the course.
- 15 It is recommended to start the renewal accreditation application 3 months before its expiry. There should be a period of at least 3 weeks from the date of application (based on complete submission of required documents via SRFAC website) to the earliest audit date provided.
- 16 Renewal audit completed after the accreditation status has lapsed, will be backdated to the stated expiry date. Accreditation status is non-transferrable.
